LBC is honored to have John Rutherford Seydel III (John R.) as our 2018 Annual Dinner keynote speaker. John, an Atlanta native, is the Director of Sustainability for the City of Atlanta Mayor's Office of Resilience, 100 Resilient Cities program pioneered by the Rockefeller Foundation. John works with department leads within the City of Atlanta, as well as with external community partners, organizations, and leaders to achieve Atlanta's sustainability and resilience goals. While in his role, John has worked on various sustainability efforts including projects supporting alternative fuel vehicles, energy and water efficiency, urban agriculture, waste diversion, and renewables. Prior to joining the Office of Resilience, John served as the CEO of Revolution Nation, worked with the Chattahoochee Riverkeeper, and currently serves on several boards including The Turner Foundation, Ideas for Us, and the Captain Planet Foundation.

The core of LBC's mission is to divert usable building materials away from landfills and back into the local community through our [Material Reuse Center](#) in Southwest Atlanta, our [Deconstruction Services](#) program and our [Nonprofit Material MATCH Program](#). LBC also offers free educational classes for community members seeking to build skills and expand their construction expertise. Since its inception in 2011, LBC has:

- Diverted **3.8 million pounds of building materials** from landfills
- Supported **155 nonprofit facility projects** with free materials
- Provided **over \$2.4 million dollars in material savings** to the community
